If the trip participant is under 18 years of age (a minor), a parent or legal guardian must sign the Release and Consent Form. The form requires information about your health care insurance coverage and emergency phone numbers. Return the signed form no later than **Wednesday, May 24th**.

If under 18, does the person take prescription drugs? Allergies? Inhalers? Please indicate on the Release & Consent Form. Minors may not have any prescription drugs in his/her possession **unless listed on the form**.

Note — No tobacco products, alcohol or illegal substances allowed anytime during the trip.

If a student does not abide by the group rules, he/she will be sent home immediately and parents or guardians will be financially responsible for his/her ticket home.

Before getting on the bus in Temple, Mrs. Tolleson will collect \$25 CASH per person for the tour guide's tip. (A personalized envelope is provided for each person. Use exact change. Families can combine envelopes.)

The round-trip chartered bus costs \$64 per person and we must collect the money by **Wednesday, May 24th**. We would prefer checks, made payable to "Clark Travel". Families can write one check together.

The chartered bus will depart from the parking lot beside Temple High at **2:30 A.M.** on Tuesday, May 30th. It will be there at 2:15 a.m. to start loading.

We will provide a brightly-colored unique piece of fabric to be tied onto all our bags so they will be easy to identify in luggage areas.

Students are encouraged to use Traveler's Checks. Give a copy of the Traveler's **Check Numbers** to Mrs. Tolleson before we leave. Don't have all money in traveler's checks. Keep some money in cash.

Breakfast is included each day. Allow \$30 per day for meals, plus money for shopping, miscellaneous, souvenirs, and possible ticket(s) to extra show(s) on Saturday. We recommend \$400 to \$500 per person.

You may want to bring **binoculars** or opera glasses since group tickets are usually in the balcony.

Airlines now charge extra for food. Last year, some food vendors opened by 6 a.m., so you could purchase breakfast items before boarding the airplane.

Everyone will need a Photo ID for security purposes at the airports.

American Airlines charges you extra if your checked bag weighs **more than 50 lbs.** We prefer one checked bag per person, but if one bag would weigh over 50 lbs., you may have to divide things and check two smaller bags.
